Course Syllabus

Class Objective:

Designed to provide a detailed understanding of the fundamentals of driving and to foster responsible attitudes and behaviors.

Also to help beginning driver's develop the knowledge, and skills necessary to become safe, low risk, responsible driver's – and to DRIVE RIGHT.

As a result of quality traffic safety instruction students will be able to :

1. Demonstrate a working knowledge of the laws governing the operation of a motor vehicle
2. Identify and analyze the physical and psychological conditions that affect driver performance
3. Apply knowledge, processes, and skills to become safe and competent users of the roads
4. Use visual search skills to make risk reducing decisions by adjusting speed and or position
5. Demonstrate balanced vehicle movement through precise and timely steering, braking and acceleration under a variety of conditions
6. Display responsible driving behaviors when alone and with peers
